AN ORDINANCE to amend the Education Ordinance with respect to the Constitution of the Education Committee.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Education Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the

2. Section 42 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—
(a) by the repeal of subsection (1) thereof, and by the substitution therefor of the following new subsection —

“(1) There shall be established an advisory committee to be styled “the Education Committee” (hereinafter referred to as the Committee), consisting of the Director of Education who shall be the chairman, and fourteen other members appointed by the Governor.”;

- (b) by the repeal of subsection (3) thereof;
(c) by the repeal of subsection (6) thereof, and by the substitution therefor of the following new subsection —

“(6) Seven members (including the presiding member) shall form a quorum.”

Passed by the Legislative Council this twenty-sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
