AN ORDINANCE to make provision for certain lots of land to be transported.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Kitty Railway Lands Ordinance, 1961.

Power to transport certain lots of land.
Cap. 145
Cap. 150.
Schedule.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary provided in subsection (5) of section 135 of the Public Health Ordinance or in section 122 of the Local Government Ordinance, where any lot of land as shown on any of the plans referred to in the schedule to this Ordinance is less than the minimum size or portions specified in the said provisions, it shall be lawful for any such lot to be transported.

SCHEDULE

Section 2

1. The Plan by J. Phang, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 26th October, 1960, and deposited in the Department of Lands and Mines on the 19th November, 1960, showing some of those lots of land known as Kitty Railway Lands being parts of Pln. Kitty in the Kitty and Alexanderville Village District, on the East Coast of the County of Demerara.

2. The plan by J. Phang, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 23rd January, 1961, and deposited in the Department of Lands and Mines on the 30th January, 1961, showing some of those lots of land known as Kitty Railway Lands being parts of Plantation Kitty in the Kitty and Alexanderville Village District, on the East Coast of the County of Demerara.
