PROPERTY TAX (AMENDMENT) BILL 1975

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title and commencement.
2. Amendment of the Property Tax (Amendment) Act 1974.

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to amend the Property Tax (Amendment) Act 1974.

A.D. 1975 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title and commencement. No. 45 of 1974.

1. This Act may be cited as the Property Tax (Amendment) Act 1975 and shall be deemed to have come into operation upon the enactment of the Property Tax (Amendment) Act 1974.

Amendment of the Property Tax (Amendment) Act 1974. No. 45 of 1974.

2. The Property Tax (Amendment) Act 1974 is hereby amended in the following respects —

(a) by the repeal of section 1 thereof and the substitution of the following section as section 1 —

“Short title and commencement. Cap. 81:21.

1. This Act, which amends the Property Tax Act, may be cited as the Property Tax (Amendment) Act 1974 and, save as otherwise provided in section 2, shall come into operation with respect to and from the year of assessment commencing on 1st January 1975.”; and

(b) by the insertion in section 2, immediately before the words “in determining” of the words “with respect to and from the year of assessment commencing on 1st January, 1970”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Property Tax (Amendment) Act 1974 for the purpose of providing the date of the effectiveness of the amendments effected to the Property Tax Act, for the purpose of implementing the proposals of the 1974 Budget Speech.
