AN ACT to amend the Police Act.

A.D. 1975. Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

1. This Act, which amends the Police Act, may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Act 1975.

2. The Principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion of the following section as section 70A immediately after section 70 —

“Remuneration
of certain
members of the
Force for execu-
ting warrants.

70A. A member of the Force of or below the rank of Sergeant may, at the request of the officer, inspector or subordinate officer under whose immediate command he is, execute any warrant when he is off duty, and for the execution thereof he shall be paid the sum of two dollars and fifteen cents or such other sum as may be fixed by order of the Minister and on the coming into operation of any such order this section shall be construed and have effect accordingly.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to provide for the remuneration of certain members of the Police Force for executing warrants when they are off duty.
