TIMEHRI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (AMENDMENT) BILL 1975

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance.
3. Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance.

A BILL

Intituled

A.D. 1975 AN ACT to amend the Timehri International Airport Ordinance.
Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title 1. This Act, which amends the Timehri International Airport Ordinance, may be cited as the Timehri International Airport (Amendment) Act 1975.

Cap. 282.
Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance. 2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words, "the catwalk leading to the Inner Location Beacon, the Inner Location Beacon site, the Outer Location Beacon site, the ILS Localiser site" immediately after the words "Bomber Dispersal Area".

Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance. 3. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects —
(a) by the substitution of the words "two hundred and fifty dollars" and "six months", for the words "twenty-four dollars" and "one month", respectively, in subsection (1); and
(b) by the substitution of the words "efficient operation of the Timehri International Airport" for the words "safety of the Airport and the public" in subsection (3).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Timehri International Airport Ordinance (Cap. 282) for the purpose of extending the definition of the term "Timehri International Airport" to include certain new installations. The Bill also seeks to provide for an increase in the maximum penalty for the breach of any regulations made under the Ordinance.
