AN ACT to amend the Interpretation and General Clauses Act.

A. D. 1975. Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title and commencement. Cap: 2:01. 1. This Act, which amends the Interpretation General Clauses Act, may be cited as the Interpretation General Clauses (Amendment) Act 1975, and shall come operation on 1st August, 1975.

Repeal and re_enact-ment of section 38 of the Principal Act.

2. Section 38 of the Principal Act is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor — $\,$

'Standard Time

- 38. (1) Subject to subsection (2), where any expression of time occurs in any written law or public document, the time referred to shall signify the standard time of Guyana which shall be three hours behind Greenwich Mean Time.
 - (2) Nothing in this section shall affect the use of local mean time for purposes of astronomy, meteorology, navigation or other purposes for which that time is adopted by international usage or the construction of any document referring to a point of time in connection with any of those purposes.".

3. The Minister assigned responsibility for legal matters (other than criminal prosecutions) may, by order which shall be subject to negative resolution of the National Assembly, amend or modify any enactment for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of section 38 of the Principal Act as repealed and re-enacted by section 2 of this Act.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Interpretation and General Clauses Act (Chapter 2:01) to provide for the standard time of Guyana to be three hours behind Greenwich Mean Time.
