"Altering of fees by council.

- 305 A. (]) Where a by-law provided for a council to alter its foes or the opening and closing hours of its facilities, which have been prescribed for in a by-law or a Schedule to a by-law, the council may before passing any resolution to do so, host a public forum, at which the proposed alteration is presented for discussion, with al! parlies to be affected by the proposed alteration thus provided with an opportunity lo indicate their concerns, objections or agreements.
- (2) A council shaU consider the concerns, objects or agreements indicated at the public forum and may make such changes if necessary, to the proposed aJtcration before it is put up for resolution by the council.
- (3) The resolved alteration shall be published in the Gazelfe and a daily newspaper circulating in Guyana, at least one month before the said alteration becomes effective.
- (4) The councii shall on application furnish to any person, a copy of the by-laws as altered, or any part thereof on a cost recovery basis.

- (5) A council before publication of any alteration shall submit to the Minister -
 - (a) a copy of the proposal for alteration discussed at the public forum;
 - (b) a copy of the minutes or other records of the public forum;
 - (c) a copy of the minutes or other records of the meeting of the council at which the alterations were adopted;
 - (d) a certificate by the clerk that the provisions in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) above were complied with; and
 - (e) copies of any objections to the alterations which have been lodged in writing with the clerk, or if no such objection has been lodged, a certificate by the clerk to that effect.
 - (6) Nothing in this section shall apply to by-law 44 of Georgetown (Abattoir) By-Laws.*
