AN ACT to amend the Constitution of Guyana in accordance with Article 164 of the Constitution of Guyana.

A.D.2013            Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.            1.        This Act, which amends the Constitution of Guyana, may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment) Act 2013.


2.        The Third Schedule to the Constitution is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following entities -

"Chambers of the Director of Public Prosecutions, the Judicial Service Commission, the Public Service Commission, the Police Service Commission, the Teaching Service Commission, the Public Service Appellate Tribunal, the Public Procurement Commission, the Office of the Ombudsman and the Guyana Elections Commission (GECOM)."

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

This Bill seeks to amend the Constitution of Guyana to add the named entities to the Third Schedule to the Constitution with the intention of enhancing the functioning of those entities by guaranteeing and strengthening their administration and control of moneys allocated to them for carrying out their functions pursuant to the Constitution.
