AN ACT to amend the Court of Appeal Act, and the High Court Act.

Short title 1. This Act, which amends the Court of Appeal Act and the High Court Act, may be cited as the Supreme Court (Judicial) (Amendment) Act, 2013.

2 Section 6 of the Court of Appeal Act is amended as follows -

(a) in subsection (5) by the deletion of paragraph (i);

(b) by the insertion immediately after subsection (5) of the following subsection as subsection (5A) -

"15A) An appeal shall lie under this section from an order made -

(a) in any civil or criminal cause or matter at the discretion of the court, or at the discretion of the court;

(b) in any civil or criminal cause or matter at the discretion of the court, or at the discretion of the court;



1. Paragraph (1) of section 71 of the High Court Act is amended by the substitution of the words "section 6 (5) or (1)" for the words "section 6 (5) (h), (c), (d), (e) or (f)".

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

The Bill seeks to amend the Court (Appellate) Act, Cap. 3:01, to provide for all appeal from the Full Court of the High Court from any order made in a criminal case or matter. It deletes paragraph (a) from section 6 (i) of the Act which prohibits appeals and inserts a new subsection (SA) making a clear statement to the effect that all appeal shall lie under section 6 from any order made by the full Court or a Judge of the High Court in any criminal case or matter at the conclusion of a criminal case or matter. It further provides that all appeal shall lie from an order in respect of the criminal case or matter for the institution of a charge or the conviction of a person in a criminal case or matter.

The Bill also seeks to amend section 71 of the High Court (Civil) Act, Cap. 3:02, to make a consequential amendment to that Act.
