EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The proposed Amendments are informed by the provisions of the Constitution of Guyana Article 146(!) which guarantees the freedom of expression and freedom to receive and disseminate information.

The amendments also give effe_ct to the Report of the 200 I Hoyte-Jagdeo Joint Committee on Broadcast and State Media the recommendations of which were ignored in sections of the Act.

The Amendments further seek to reduce the overarching influence of the Minister responsible $\hat{\mathbf{b}}_r$ Broadcast in the appointment and functioning of the Guyana National Broadcast Authority.
