AN ACT to amend the Evidence Act.

A.O. 2013 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short Title. 1. This Act, which amends the Evidence Act, may be cited as the Evidence Cap. 5:03. (Amendment) Act 2013.

Amendment of section 43 of the principal Act. 2. Section 43 of the Principal Act is amended as follows

- (a) by substituting the following subsection for subsection (4) -
 - "(4) The provisions of this sections shall, with the necessary modifications, apply to a document purporting to be -
 - (a) a post mortem report of a duly registered medical practitioner;
 - (b) a report made by a duly registered medical practitioner within forty-eight hours of his examination of any injury received or the condition of a person which is the subject of a prosecution for a criminal offence;
 - (c) a certificate or report signed or purported to be signed byan analyst stating that he has analysed or examined -
 - (i) a finger print; -
 - (ii) a firearm or ammunition;
 - (iii) a poisonous and noxious substance;
 - (iv) a firearm or ammunition;
 - (v) a local or foreign currency;
 - (vi) human blood, bone or tissues; or
 - (vi) fuel or fuel based substance, and the results of his analysis or examination; and
 - (d) a certificate issued by the police Forensic Laboratory and signed by an analyst of the Guyana Police Force.

- (b) by substituting the following subsection for subsection (5)-
 - "(5) In this sction the expression "analyst" means a government analyst, an assistant government analyst, a radiologist, a government bacteriologist_ and pathologist, a scientific officer of the Guyana Police Force or any other qualified person that the Minister may by order prescribe.".

The **Insurance Act, Cap 91:03** is amended to require the Commissioner of Insurance to ensure that criminals are prevented from being the holders of interests or management in insurance companies. It introduces and clarifies certain confidential obligations on the part of directors, inspectors and employees.
