CONSTITUTION REFORM COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) BILL 2024

1. (1) This Act, which amends the Constitution Reform Commission Act 2022, may be cited as the Constitution Reform Commission (Amendment) Act 2024.

(2) The amendments to this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation from 15th November, 2022.

section 3 of the

2. Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for the word “twenty” the word “twenty-one”.

Amendment of
section 4 of the
Principal Act.

3. Section 4 (1) of the Principal Act is amended as follows-


- (a) in subparagraph (l), by deleting the word “and”;
- (b) in subparagraph (m), by substituting for the “full stop” the words “; and”; and
- (c) by inserting after subparagraph (m) the following-
“(n) one member nominated by the President.”.

Explanatory Memorandum

This Bill seeks to amend the **Constitution Reform Commission Act 2022**. The amendments contained in this Bill shall take effect from the 15th November, 2022.

Clause 2 of the Bill seeks to amend section 3 of the Principal Act to increase the membership of the Commission from twenty members to twenty-one members.

Clause 3 of the Bill seeks to amend section 4(1) of the Principal Act to provide for the President to nominate a member of the Commission.
