

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend section 34(1) of the Court of Appeal Act, Cap. 3:01. Presently, this section provides that the judges of the Court of Appeal shall include not less than five and not more than nine Justices of Appeal.

**Clause 2 of this Bill** amends section 34(1) of the Principal Act to increase the maximum number of Justices of Appeal from nine to eleven.
