AN ACT to amend the Customs Act.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana -A.D. 2007

Short title and This Act, which amends the Customs Act, may be cited as the 1. commencement. Customs (Amendment) Act 2007 and shall come into operation on 1" Cap. 82:01 February, 2007.

Insertion of new section 67A in the Principal Act.

The Principal Act is amended by the insertion of a new section 67A 2. immediately after section 67.

^HAdvance Dassenger and cargo information

67A. (1) Without prejudice to section 67, the Minister may make regulations requiring any master of an aircraft or ship expected to arrive in Guyana or expected to depart from Guyana to furnish advance information relating to any passenger or cargo or both on board of such aircraft or ship in the form and manner as may be provided in the regulations.

(2)Where a master of an aircraft or ship who is required to furnish any advance information under the regulation made under sub-section (1)-

- (a) intentionally fails to furnish the advance information; or
- **(b)** recklessly furnishes incomplete or false advance information.

he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty million dollars as may be prescribed in the regulations.".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Customs Act (Cap. 82:01)

Clause 1 of the Bill sets out the short title.

Clause 2 seeks to insert a new section 67A in the Customs Act so as to provide for making of regulations requiring the master of an aircraft or ship arriving in or departing from Guyana to furnish advance information relating to any passenger or cargo or both. It also proposed to provide that the regulations may specify imposition of a penalty of twenty million dollars on the master of an aircraft or ship who intentionally fails to furnish the requisite advance information or recklessly furnishes incomplete or false advance information.
