Short title.

1. This Act, which amends the Guyana Presbyterian Church Act 1974, may be cited as the Guyana Presbyterian Church Act 1974 (Amendment) Act 2007.

Amendments of the Principal Act. 2. The sections specified in the first column of the Schedule are hereby amended in the manner specified in the corresponding entry in the second column of that Schedule.

Section 2	For the word "Presbytery" substitute the word "Synod".
Section 4	For the word "Presbytery" substitute the word "Synod".
Section 5	For the word "Presbytery" substitute the word "Synod".

Section 9 (1)	For the words "two members of the Board and the Secretary of the Board" substitute the words "the Chairman and Secretary of the Board and one other member of the Board".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Guyana Presbyterian Church Act 1974 to replace the Presbytery with the Synod as the governing body of the Church in Guyana.

The Bill also seeks to amend Section 9 to provide that the Chairman and Secretary of the Board and one other member of the Board may formally execute any document once it is signed by those members.
