CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) BILL 2009

AN ACT to alter the Constitution in accordance with Articles 66 and 64.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment) Act 2009.


2. The Constitution is altered by inserting immediately after Article 119C the following as Article 119D —

“Parliamentary
Oversight
Committee on the
Security Sector.

119D. There shall be a Standing Committee of the National Assembly to be named the Parliamentary Oversight Committee on the Security Sector and it shall have responsibility for examining the policies and administration of the entities in the Security sector, namely the Disciplined Forces of Guyana.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Constitution by inserting a new Article 119D to the Constitution providing for a Standing Committee called the Parliamentary Oversight Committee on the Security Sector having responsibility for the policies and administration of the Disciplined Forces of Guyana.
