
1. This Act, which amends the Customs Act, may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Act 2015.

Repeal of section

2. Section 7A of the Principal Act is repealed.

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

**This Bill** seeks to amend the Customs Act, Cap. 82:01, by repealing section 7A which provides for the collection by the Commissioner General of the Guyana Revenue Authority of environment tax on every unit of non-returnable container of imported beverage. Upon repeal of section 7A predominant stakeholders and the Government would hold discussions in an effort to craft legislation that meets general acceptance and consensus.
