AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consqlidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana for the fiscal year ending 31 st December, 2011, 31 st December, 2012 and 31 st December, 2014, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and foff the appropriation of those sums for the specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. for 2015)

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of such sums, not exceeding in the aggregate the gross of three billion, two hundred and thirty nine million, six hundred and one thousand and the hundred and sixty six dollars (\$3,239,601,366), necessary to meet the expenditure of Guyana for the fiscal years ending on 31 st December, 201 I, 31 st December 2012 and 31 st December 2014, is hereby authorised in accordance with article 219 of the Constitution and sections 24 and 41 of the Fiscal Management and Accountability Act 2003.
