SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (NO. BILL 2015)

Intituled

AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana for the fiscal year ending 31st December, 2011, 31st December, 2012 and 31st December, 2014, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of those sums for the specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

A.D.2015. Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

- Short title.* 1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. for 2015) Act 2015.
- Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised*
No. ZO/2003. 2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of such sums, not exceeding in the aggregate the gross of three billion, two hundred and thirty nine million, six hundred and one thousand and three hundred and sixty six dollars (\$3,239,601,366), necessary to meet the expenditure of Guyana for the fiscal years ending on 31st December, 2011, 31st December 2012 and 31st December 2014, is hereby authorised in accordance with article 219 of the Constitution and sections 24 and 41 of the Fiscal Management and Accountability Act 2003.
- Appropriation Schedule.* 3. Every sum set out in the Schedule is hereby appropriated for the purposes specified therein with effect from 1st January, 2011, 1st January, 2012 and 1st January, 2014.
