1. This Act, which amends the Factories Hours and Holidays Act, may be cited as the Factories Hours and Holidays (Amendment) Act 1999.

2. Section 2 (1) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "fourteen" of the word "fifteen" in the definition of "child".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Factories Hours and Holidays Act, Cap. 95:02 to bring it in conformity with the International Labour Organisation No. 138 which provides for the minimum age for employment to be fifteen years.
