Short title.

1. This Act, which amends the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 2016.

Cap 51:02

2. The provisions of the Principal Act specified in column one of the Table are amended in the manner specified in the corresponding entries in column two.


SECTION	AMENDMENT
Section 9(1)(b)	<p>(a) by substituting for the words “registration, the prescribed fee” the words “registration and the prescribed fee”;</p> <p>(b) by deleting immediately after the words “prescribed fees” the words “and a certificate of the Commissioner-General Guyana Revenue Authority stating that the registered owner has in accordance with section 60 of the Income Tax Act delivered to the Commissioner General Guyana Revenue Authority all his returns, including the return for the preceding year of income, and has paid all taxes due and payable to the Commissioner by him or has made arrangements to the satisfaction of the Commissioner for the payment of all such taxes that are due and payable”.</p>



**EXPLANATORY MOMORANDUM**

This Bill seeks to amend Section 9 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chapter 51:02, to dispense with the requirement for Motor Vehicle Compliance from the Revenue Authority.

This Bill also seeks to amend the First Schedule to the Act by increasing fees for the transfer of motor cycles and other motor vehicles and by imposing fees for the issuance of letters of Authenticity and driving permits by the Revenue Authority
