THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE
(Chapter 5)

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY DEPUTE THE PERSON MENTIONED IN THE FIRST COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE HEREUNDER TO EXERCISE ON MY BEHALF THE POWER SPECIFIED IN THE SECOND COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE GENERAL LOANS (INTERNATIONAL BANK) ORDINANCE, 1960, (NO. 13 OF 1960), MENTIONED IN THE THIRD COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE:—
