
IN THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER: -

- Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the National Industrial and Commercial Investment Limited (Vesting of Property) Order 2002.
- Interpretation. 2. In this Order
- Cap. 89:01  
No. 29 of 1991 "NICIL" means National Industrial and Commercial Investments Limited, being a company incorporated in Guyana under the Companies Act and continued under the Companies Act 1991, having its registered office situated at 126 Barrack Street, Kingston, Georgetown, Demerara.
- Vesting of property. 3. The immovable property described in the Schedule owned by the Government on behalf of the State and which is at present in the possession of NICIL is hereby vested in NICIL.

SCHEDULE

Block 'X' consisting of lots numbered 1-37 (one to thirty-seven) being portion of Area 'H' being portion of Plantation Coldingen now known as Plantation Non Pariel (West) of the East Coast of Demerara, in the county of Demerara, Guyana and consisting of an area 35.3 (thirty-five decimal three) acres as shown on a Plan by J. Ramnauth, Government Surveyor dated 17<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1994 and deposited in the Deeds Registry on 13<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1995 the said area 'H' containing an area of 53.655 (fifty-three decimal six five five) acres and being shown on a Plan by David H.E. Howard, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 19<sup>th</sup> January, 1973 and deposited in the Deeds Registry on the 14<sup>th</sup> June 1973 no building thereon.
